

# Outline of the 46th SSEAYP in 2019

## 1. History and purpose

The Ship for Southeast Asian and Japanese Youth Program (SSEAYP) was launched as the joint program among Japan and ASEAN member countries in January 1974. This program has been carried out all the years that follow. This year, it marks the 46th program.

Ten ASEAN member countries and Japan participate in this program. SSEAYP aims to promote friendship and mutual understanding among the promising youth of ASEAN and Japan, as well as to nurture leadership of prominent youth in the region.
